Developing Digitally-rich Urban Teacher Leaders: Fostering and Sustaining a STEM Culture of Belonging, Access, Justice, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (Be-A-JEDI)

Program Requirements

- Open to all certified 7-12 math and science teachers from Elmira, Hornell, Jamestown, RCSD, and Salamanca who have a completed master's degree (not in special education).
- Applicants must be in a full-time tenure track position with responsibility of teaching at least 50% in 7-12 math or science for the duration of this grant.
- Commitment to participate in all project activities including the two summer immersion experiences in summers of 2023 and 2024
- Maintain district employment for the full 5 years of the grant

Selection Process

- Review of all application materials (application, résumé or curriculum vitae, video submission, vision statement, and Colleague Reference Form)
- Conversation with administrator/direct supervisor
- Interview by members of the Noyce Be-A-JEDI Leadership Team

Preference will be given to candidates with at least 3 years of teaching experience and equitable selection across partnering school districts and disciplines will be considered.

- Upload a current **résumé or curriculum vitae**
- **Upload your vision statement.**

In one to two pages, please address the following prompts:

- What's your vision for serving as a teacher leader in your context?
- How does this vision connect to the elements of Be-A-JEDI (**B**elonging, **A**ccess, **J**ustice, **E**quity, **D**iversity, and **I**nclusion)?
- What do you hope to get out of this program to help meet your vision?

Step 4: Choose and notify a colleague with whom you have professionally collaborated and have them complete the **Colleague Reference Form** at the following [link](#):

Step 5: Notify your direct supervisor or principal that you have applied for the fellowship, and that they will be receiving a phone call from one of our Leadership Team members to discuss your application.

Step 6: Video Submission - Be-A-JEDI is an acronym that puts together important features of ideal classrooms. Belonging, Access, Justice-centered, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion are ideals in education that support learning. Submit a video clip of your teaching practice (no longer than 15 minutes) that shows how you and your classroom connect to one or more of the Be-A-JEDI ideals. This glimpse into your classroom is a way to see you as a candidate in a more nuanced and textured way. Submit your video at the following [link](#):

- Requirements:
 - Submit a video (max 15 min) that illustrates one way you and your practice connects to the ideals supporting the grant.
 - A brief description (3-5 sentences) of the connection you are illustrating in the video.
 - (optional) - lesson plans/materials used during the video.



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
